WHAT WENT WELL

Positive signals

- ✓ PPE compliance hit **96%** in afternoon shift — highest this month
- ✓ No restricted zone breaches in Zone C for 4 consecutive hours
- ✓ Lithium battery thermal anomaly verified and cleared in **under 3 minutes**
- ✓ Supervisor response time improved **34%** vs yesterday

COACHING OPPORTUNITIES

What to focus on tomorrow

Weighbridge congestion peaked at 10:30am

Pattern observed for 3 consecutive days. Consider staggered breaks for ground crew.

Sorting area PPE checks dropped at shift change

Reinforce hi-vis requirement during 14:00 handover briefing.

Plant crossing forklift / pedestrian timing

Update site induction with peak forklift movement window (08:30–09:30).

AI PATTERN INSIGHT — THIS WEEK

Vehicle-pedestrian proximity events at the **Weighbridge** have increased **23%** over the past 7 days, with one operator (ID redacted) flagged in 4 of 9 events. Recommended action: brief team at next pre-start, and consider repainting pedestrian walkway lines — visibility down due to weathering. Evidence pack ready for review.

READ AT TOOLBOX · ~120 SECONDS

- 1 Yesterday:** 23 events, 1 critical (lithium battery thermal — cleared in 3 min). Safety score up to 87.
- 2 Watch zone today:** Weighbridge between 10:00 and 11:00. Vehicle-pedestrian proximity is trending up — eyes up, take the long way around.
- 3 One thing to do better:** hi-vis at the 14:00 handover. We dropped compliance there yesterday. Don't let it slip today.
- 4 Shout out:** afternoon shift hit 96% PPE compliance — best this month. Keep it up.
